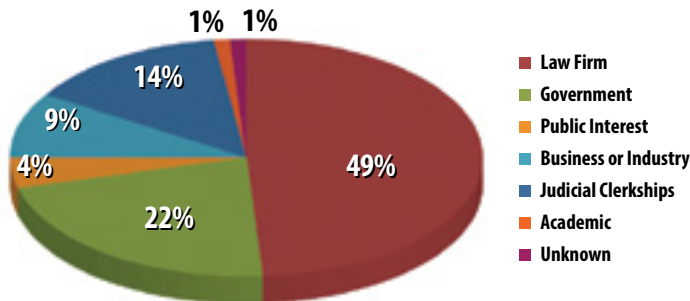

9 MONTH EMPLOYMENT BY EMPLOYER TYPE - CLASS OF 2013

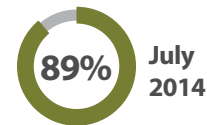
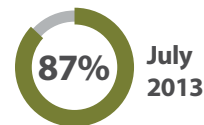


9 MONTH EMPLOYMENT STATUS - CLASS OF 2013

- Hold, or will have earned by the time of matriculation, a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university or its foreign equivalent.
- A current LSAT score or plans to take the LSAT during the application process.
