Dear Prospective Transfer Student:

Congratulations on completing your 1L year and best of luck as you consider transferring to the University of New Mexico School of Law. As you think through this important decision, we wanted you to know that transfer students are eligible to become members of the *New Mexico Law Review* or *Natural Resources Journal*.

To be considered, inform your admissions officer within three days of accepting an offer to matriculate at the School of Law. A Write-On Packet and anonymous ID will be mailed to you. You will have **exactly two weeks** from the date you receive this information to complete the Write-On packet. This is the same amount of time on-campus students receive and your submission will be evaluated according to the same process. A timely submitted packet is considered an application to both journals. No changes to the application timeline outlined above will be considered.

Again, good luck with the transfer process and we hope it results in your acceptance and matriculation to the UNM School of Law.
